ABOUT THE CANDIDATES

Owen Henry. Mr. Henry is a lifelong resident of Old Bridge, a local businessman and active volunteer. Brian J. Cahill is seeking re-election to his second term as Councilman at Large. Mr. Cahill has been a resident of Old Bridge since 1994. Eleanor “Debbie” Walker has been a resident of Old Bridge since 1988. Ms. Walker is the President of Fire Commissioners for District #2, a small business owner and has been very active in volunteer activities including Cheesequake Volunteer Fire Company, Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Cheesequake Baseball, Ladies Auxiliary and the Mid-Madison Women’s club. Debbie ran for Council in Ward 1 during the 2009 race and was narrowly defeated by 33 votes against a long time incumbent in a Ward that is a Democratic stronghold.

Dr. James Anderson is new to the campaign trail but not new to Old Bridge politics. Dr. Anderson has been a resident of Old Bridge since 1998. Jim is a small business owner who has run his own practice (Dentist) for the last 31 years. He understands the benefits of lower taxes on job creators and brings a wealth of knowledge to the team.
